This session will help participants understand how to engage the faith community in addressing substance abuse issues in their jurisdiction. Faith Partners, Inc. was developed in 2004 and is located in Austin, Texas. Their purpose is to launch a fresh, nationwide campaign to equip people in congregations to respond to problems of alcohol and other drugs. Faith Partners facilitators will provide the tools and training to equip congregations with an effective, comprehensive and sustainable lay ministry for that purpose.

You will also hear from the president of the Harford County, Maryland coalition FACE-IT (Faith Activated Community Empowering Intervention Training) a DFC recipient with a county government fiduciary agent. They will explain the strategy that they used to initiate contact with faith leaders and their progression to utilizing the Faith Partners training to organize and sustain over 30 congregational ministries in their county.
